DESIGN INTENT

Renewed for tomorrow

A monochromatic palette built around the Redsand PCR shell — recycled polypropylene that draws on Sebel's iconic red heritage while staying warm, contemporary and commercially accessible.

The cushion is new for this release: Warwick Augustus Pimpernel fabric, approximately 70% recycled wool, over a recycled foam inner — a premium feel with a genuine sustainability story.

HERITAGE

An Australian Original

The Hobnob is one of the enduring icons designed for Sebel by Charles Furey (1917–2009) — a founding member of the Society of Designers for Industry, established in Melbourne in 1947, and one of the most significant industrial designers Australia has produced.

Originally engineered for the rigours of clubs and hotels, the Hobnob paired sculptural, ergonomic comfort with genuine commercial durability. Several examples are held today in the Powerhouse Museum's permanent design collection.

1971

Designed by Charles Furey for Sebel — founded in Sydney in 1951 by Harry Sebel. The Hobnob introduced a sculptural moulded shell engineered for comfort, durability and constant commercial use.

1970s

Produced in both armchair and side-chair forms, with a range of leg styles over the years — built for the everyday wear of clubs, hotels and hospitality venues across Australia.

2026

Re-issued for a new generation in a 75-piece anniversary edition marking Sebel's 75th year — the same iconic silhouette, with refined upholstery and recycled materials.

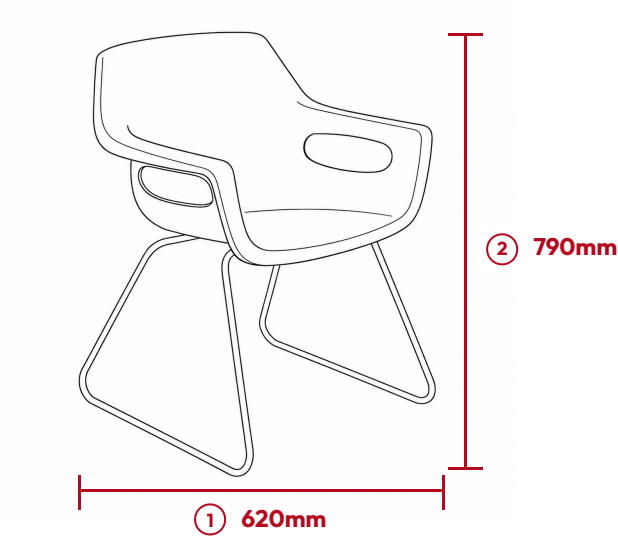

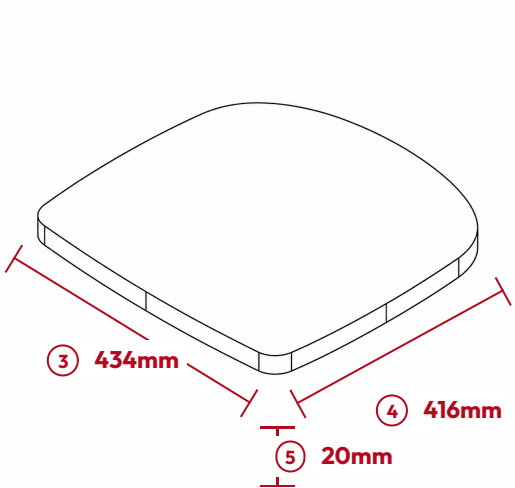
